With USDA Rural Development support through a REDA grant, CT RC&D's Connecticut Farm Energy Audit Program is able to offer funding to cover 75% of the cost of your energy audit. The remaining 25% cost is paid by the farm. Your energy audit can be used to access funding through USDA programs such as the Rural Energy for America Program (REAP), which provides grants and loan guarantees for your energy efficient projects.

Receive your audit within 8 weeks of sending in your materials, and use your audit to make business decisions that reduce your operating costs, improve your energy efficiency and access funding.
